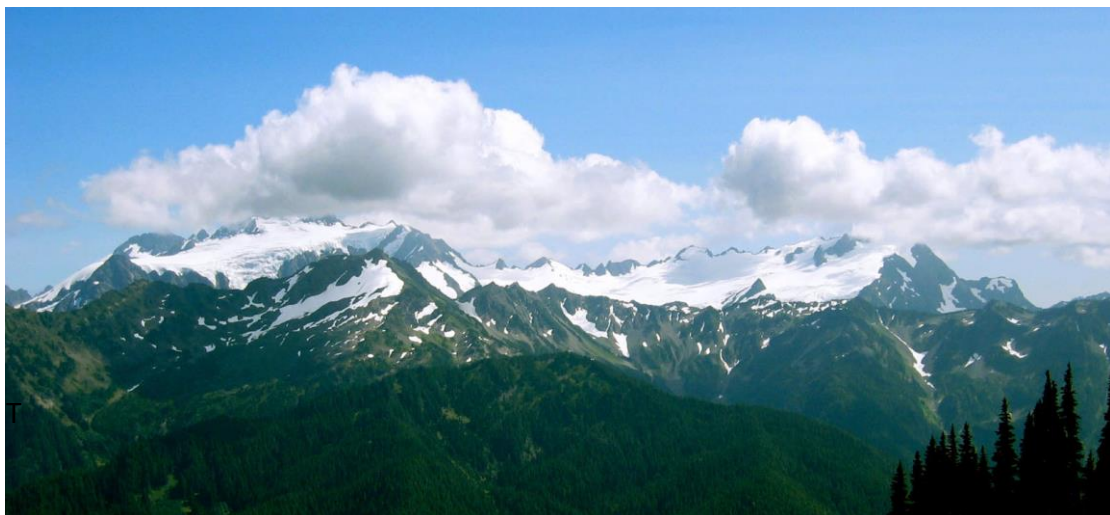

Greece

The capital of Greece is Athens with a population of 664.046 inhabitants in 2011. Also the population of Greece is 10.72 million people in 2019. Most of Europe extends to the eastern hemisphere except for a small part belonging to the western hemisphere and the northern temperature zone except for a small part to its northern part belonging to the northern polar circle. Greece borders Albania to the north-west.



The soil of Greece is mainly mountainous or boulevard. Most of it is dry and rocky while only 20.45% of the soil is cultivated. The highest mountain in Greece is Olympus.

Greece has also several lakes, most of which are located on the mainland. One of the largest lakes in Greece is Trichonida.



Finally, Greece has over 2,500 islands of which only about 165 are inhabited. One of the most popular islands is Evia!
