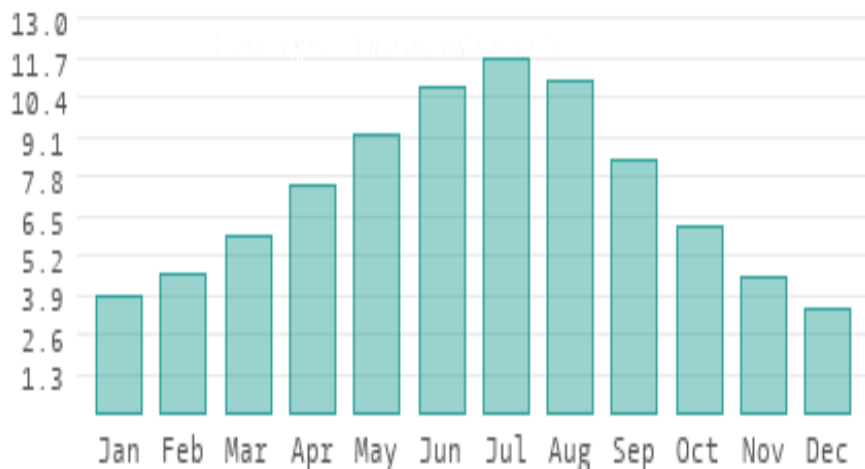


Greece is famous for its mountains, islands and rivers. The three highest mountains are Mount Olympus, Mount Smolikas and Mount Parnassos.
